2023 UCHA Year End Award Series

- Based on most money won except the youth which will be based on points
- All approved shows - in-state and out-of-state - are included.
- The next two places after the saddle winner will receive awards.
- Membership in the UCHA at the time of showing for both owner and rider required to be eligible.
- ***A class must have sufficient entries to be held at least sixty (60%) of the time to be eligible for a saddle.***
- ***A cutter must attend and attempt to show at least fifty (50%) of the shows (each day is a show) to be eligible for the saddle in each class. Saddles will be presented to the high money winner that qualifies for the 50% rule. Next two places will be based on money won only.***

Starting for the 2022-23 Youth Class standings - Championship Saddles will be awarded for both junior and senior youth. A cutter must attend and attempt to show at least fifty (50%) of the shows (each day is a show) to be eligible for the saddle in each class. Saddles will be presented to the high money winner that qualifies for the 50% rule. Next two places will be based on money won only. The Youth calendar year runs from June 1st to May 31st
