## Corvid Show Health and Safety

Based on the current mandatory guidelines set forth by the Weber County Fairgrounds, city of Ogden and State of Utah. NOTICE: A wristband is required to be worn by all show participants during the show – wristbands will be given after a release of liability is signed.

### **FACE COVERINGS/FACEMASKS:**

When not mounted on a horse, all attendees must wear a face covering while inside the Golden Spike Events Center. Face coverings are also required while watching in the stands, concession areas and show office. Where 6' distancing can not be maintained, face covers will be required.

### **SOCIAL DISTANCING**

Social distance practices (6') are in effect in ALL AREAS of the show grounds. Please maintain a 6' distance whenever possible.

### **THE SHOW OFFICE**

Limited people allowed in the office area at any given time. Please be courteous, allow yourself enough time to wait for others, things may take a little longer.
