

UTAH CUTTING HORSE ASSOCIATION FUTURITY & AGED EVENT

Rules & Regulations

- 1. Entries & Registration papers:** Entries are due October 14 (7 days grace period). Please make all entries online. Registration papers are required on all horses. Proof in the form of a photocopy of the registration certificate or a veterinarians statement of age and description must be submitted with all entries.
- 2. NCHA & UCHA Membership:** Both rider and owner must be current members of NCHA and UCHA
- 3. Stalls:** Stalls are due October 14. Weekend only stalls are \$110. LAE only stalls are \$145. Stalls for the entire time are \$180. Each stall comes with 3 bags of shavings. Please use stall form for reserving the stalls. Stalls will be available Tuesday before the event but not before.
- 4. Horses:** The aged event is for futurity (3 year olds), derby (4 year olds) and Classic/Challenge (5/6 year olds). Each division will have an open and non pro. The derby and classic/challenge will each have an 50,000 amateur. The derby open will have a 10,000 Ltd Horse class. The classic/challenge open will have a 25,000 Ltd Horse class. Each open and non pro will have an intermediate class.
- 5. Ties:** If any two riders tie for the championship of any class, Co-Champions shall be declared. First and second place monies will be divided equally. The highest accumulative score of the two go rounds and the finals will determine awards. Three way or greater ties shall be worked off with one being determined as Champion and remainder as Co-Reserve. The money will be split equally.
- 6. Classes:** Riders may ride unlimited entries in divisions they qualify for.
 - **Open** - 2 go rounds and a finals
 - **Non Pro** – 2 go rounds and a finals
 - **50,000 Amateur** – 1 go round and a finals
 - **100,000 Intermediate Open Rider Open & 100,000 Intermediate Non Pro Rider:** The open and non pro will be held within the 2nd go round of each of their respective divisions. You can enter this division only or make it a combination. If a combination a \$160 deduction will be granted as a horse cannot walk to the herd twice in the 2nd go round. This division will be one go round and a finals.
 - **Gelding, Senior & 200,000 Ltd Rider** – these divisions are a class within a class in the open and non pro divisions. The gelding division will also be offered as a class within a class in the intermediate divisions also. The senior division will also be offered as a class within a class in the intermediate non pro divisions. The amateur class will offer the gelding and senior classes within a class.
 - **Derby Open 10,000 Ltd Horse-** This division will be held within the derby open division. A horse may be entered only in this division or as a combination. If a combination a \$160 reduction will be made as a horse cannot walk to the herd twice in the 2nd go round. This division will be one go round and a finals.
 - **Classic/Challenge Open 25,000 Ltd Horse:** this division will be held within the 1st go round of the classic/challenge open division. A horse may be entered only in this division or as a combination. If a combination a \$160 reduction will be made as a horse cannot walk to the herd twice in the go round. This division will be one go round and a finals.
 - **Futurity Open Consolation class:** Eligibility: Horse must have been entered in either the futurity open and/or futurity open intermediate. This class is open to all 3 year old horses who do not make the finals in either of the two divisions. Entries are due by the end of the day of the 2nd go round of the futurity open. It is just one go round.
 - **Any Age Horse/Non Pro rider:** This class is open to any age horse with a non pro rider. It is one go round and a finals.
- 7. Eligibility:**
 - **100,000 Intermediate Rider:** Within the current and the immediate previous two show years, the rider must not have won in excess of \$100,000 LTE monies per NCHA rules for those combined calendar show years. (Based on earnings from January 1, 2018 to October 1, 2020) Rider's eligibility is based on money only and not age of rider. Hall of Fame riders who qualify may show.
 - **Derby Open 10,000 Ltd Horse:** Lifetime earnings of less than \$10,000 on NCHA records as of October 1 of current year.
 - **Classic/challenge 25,000 Ltd Horse:** Lifetime earnings of less than \$25,000 on NCHA records as of October 1 of current year.
 - **200,000 Ltd Rider:** This is a class within the open or non pro divisions. Eligibility is based on eligibility earnings

as determined by NCHA eligibility as of January 1.

- **Senior:** This is a class within the non pro, intermediate np or amateur divisions. **This is for riders 55 and up.**

8. Advancement:

- **Derby Open & Non Pro & Classic/Challenge Open & Non Pro.** 70% will advance to the 2nd go round. 30% will advance to the finals.
- **Futurity Open & Non Pro** - All will advance to the 2nd go except scratched entries and those receiving a 0. 30% will advance to the finals.
- **Any Age Horse/Non Pro.** 30% will advance to the finals
- **Derby Open 10,000 Ltd Horse.** 30% will advance to the finals.
- **Derby & Classic/Challenge Amateur.** 30% will advance to the finals.
- **Intermediate Open Rider & Intermediate Non Pro Rider:** 30% will advance to the finals.
- **There must be 10 horses to have a working finals. Finals will be a minimum of 5 and a maximum of 20 plus ties to the finals. Any division with less than 10 horses will be a pencil finals.**

9. Payout:

- **Open and non pro divisions** will pay one place for every ten entries with a maximum of two in the go rounds. Five percent (5%) of jackpotted purse will be paid in each go round with 90% of the jackpotted purse plus the added money will be paid in the finals. All horses advancing to finals will receive a check.
- **Classes with one go round:** No money will be paid in the go round. All money will be paid in the finals with all finalists receiving a check.
- **Gelding, 200,000 Ltd Rider and Seniors:** Payout will be made to the furthestmost advancing 30% of entries.

11 **NCHA rules** will be followed as long as they don't conflict with the UCHA Futurity rules.
